I have been asked by Shari to turn in my key to the Library. I believe she will be at the meeting. This key also gives access to the Food Shelf and Hokah Heritage Room. I like to work on the Heritage room when the Library is closed, otherwise I have a hard time getting anything done. The most urgent need is access to the Food Shelf.
