

ORDINANCE NO. 35 An Ordinance to prohibit the operation of gambling devices.

The President and Trustees of the village of Hokah do ordain as follows.

SECTION 1.

Whoever suffers, within the corporate limits of the village of Hokah, any gaming table, faro bank, slot machine, or other gambling device to be set up or used for the purpose of gambling, in any house, building, lot, yard, boat, or garden to him belonging or by him occupied, or of which he has the control shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than ten (\$10) dollars nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100) or by imprisonment in the county jail not less than fifteen (15) days nor more than ninety (90) days.

SECTION 2.

Any ordinance or ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the 6th day of August A.D. 1903
