

ORDINANCE NO. 55: An Ordinance for the Purpose of Promoting Health, Safety, Order, Convenience and General Welfare by Prohibiting the Location of Cesspools and Sewage Pits from an Area Adjacent to the Hokah Village of Water Well Site in the Village of Hokah, Minnesota.

The Village Council of the Village of Hokah in Houston County, Minnesota, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: Prohibition:

It shall be unlawful for any person or corporation to erect, or cause to be erected, or maintain any cesspool or sewage pit within a distance of one-hundred fifty (150) feet from the Hokah, Minnesota well site, which well site is described as being in said Village, viz:

One Hundred Seventeen (117) feet North of the Center Line of "A" Street extended and One Hundred Seventeen (117) feet West of the Center Line of Seventh Street, said Streets being in the Village of Hokah, Minnesota, according to the recorded plat thereof file and of record in the Office of the Houston County, Minnesota, Register of Deeds, all in the Northeast Quarter of Section Six (6), Township One Hundred Three (103) North, Range Four (4) West.

SECTION 2: Penalties.

Any person who violates or fails to comply with any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed One Hundred and no/100 Dollars (\$100.00), or by imprisonment in the County Jail for not to exceed ninety (90) days for each offense. Each day that the violation is permitted to continue to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3:

This Ordinance become effective upon its passage and publication as provided by law.
