

ORDINANCE NO. 61

AN ORDINANCE NAMING AND RENAMIEING CERTAIN PUBLIC STREETS IN
THE VILLAGE OF HOKAH, HOUSTON COUNTY
MINNESOTA

WHEREAS, Certain streets in said Village of Hokah do not now bear official names and

WHEREAS, Certain other streets in said Village for the purpose of avoiding confusion and for aesthetic reasons, are required to be renamed.

BET IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Council of the Village of Hokah, state of Minnesota, as follows:

ARTICLE 1

That certain streets in the original plat to the Village of Hokah according ot the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of Register of deeds in and for Houston County Minnesota, designated "A" street be renamed to "Ash" Street and that that certain street in said original plat designated as "B" street be renamed "Birch" street.

ARTICLE 11

That that certain street in Thompson, Jones and Padelford's addition according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of deeds in and for Houston County, Minnesota designated as "C" street be renamed "Cedar" street. That that certain street in said plat designated "D" street be renamed "Dogwood" street.

ARTICLE 111

That that certain street in the Village of which traverses Clark W. Thompson's Subdivision Millblock, Hokah, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Houston County, Minnesota, lying generally southerly and westerly of lots 1, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, and 25 and generally northerly and easterly of lots 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, and 2, heretofore not official named be designated and named "Falls" Street.

ARTICLE 1V

That that certain street in the Village of Hokah described as commencing at a point on the centerline of Houston County State Aid Road No. 18 in the Village of Hokah, which point is 120 feet northeasterly of the point of intersection of the centerline of said road and the north line of the southeast quarter of the township 103 north of Range 4 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, thence in a northeasterly direction along the center of the Village street as presently located a distance of approximately 655 feet to the point where said centerline of said Village street intersects Frist street and Babcock and Thompson's addition to the Village of Hokah according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Houston County, Minnesota, which point is 66 feet west and 90 feet north of the southwest corner of lot 7 of Block 19 in said Babcock and Thompson's Addition and there terminating, heretofore unnamed be designated and "Como" Avenue.

ARTICLE V

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication according to law.
