

ORDINANCE NO. 71

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 62 BEING AN
ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR LICENSING THE SALE OF
INTOXICATING AND SPIRITUOUS LIQUORS ON SUNDAY WITHIN THE
VILLAGE OF HOKAH, HOUSTON COUNTY, STATE OF MINNESOTA

The Village Council of the Village of Hokah, Houston County, Minnesota,
ordains:

1. Ordinance No. 62 of the Village of Hokah is hereby amended so as to insert an additional section following "Section 1" and numbered Section 1.1 reading as follows:

"Section 1.1 In order to be eligible for application for license to sell liquor on Sunday within the meaning of this Ordinance, establishment or establishments making application for such license shall be establishments serving food and for purposes of this ordinance "serving food shall be construed to mean maintenance of facilities for making available complete or full meals seven days per week and not merely serving such food on Sundays."

2. This ordinance shall take effect and be enforced upon its passage and adoption and its publication as provided by law.
