

ORDINANCE NO. 89

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PARKING IN THE  
CITY OF HOKAH AND ESTABLISHING MAXIMUM  
PARKING LIMITATIONS ON CERTAIN DESIGNATED  
STREETS THEREIN

The City Council of the City of Hokah, Houston County, Minnesota hereby ordains:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle on the north side of Main Street in the City of Hokah, Houston County, Minnesota, from the West entrance of the East parking lot to lot 7 of Block F of the Original Plat of Hokah presently occupied by the Jehovah Witnesses for a continual period of longer than one hour on Friday of each week between the hours of 4 o'clock P.M. and 9 o'clock P.M.

Section 2. Any person who violates any provisions of this Ordinance upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$3.00.

Section 3. This Ordinance becomes effective from and after its passage, adoption and publication as required by law.
